He came with his parents to St. Louis, Mo., and he was united in marriage in 1868 with Miss Anna HOSPOTSKY. To this union was born 7 children, 4 of whom have passed on before; three children with his wife survive him. He lived in St. Louis 30 years; he was foreman for 27 years. He moved with his family to Marion county, Ill., in 1894. He leaves besides his family, three sisters, Mrs. Bertha KOESTER, of St. Louis, Mrs. Otto, of Omega, Mrs. Minnie WILKEY of San Antonio, Tex.; one brother, Wm. HENNEMAN of St. Louis, and other relatives and friends to mourn their loss. <i>(“The Kinmundy Express” – Oct. 28, 1909)</i></p>
