Sept. 30, 1846 Married Robert SMITH Nee EASTHAM (information from cemetery writeup) BIO: Catharine Frances ?-Turner-Jones-Carpenter-Pyles was my husband's great, great grandmother. She was born in Henry County, Kentucky. She may have been the daughter of Robert C. Smith and Elizabeth Neville. There are many factors that leads to this conclusion. She is also listed in the cemetery as Catharine F. Smith, added to site by a Smith family researcher. Catharine does fit in census wise to be one of Robert's daughters. Catharine married Joseph Burch Turner round 1841. Their first born child Matilda was born on 10-26-1842. The published History of Clay Co., Illinois states that Robert Smith arrived in 1840 from Henry Co. Ky. This is backed up by the 1840 census. This history also stated that the Jones and Turner families arrived in around 1843 from Henry Co. I believe they arrived by late 1840 early 1841. This is based on the fact that Samuel and Sarah Smith-Jones's son John married Samuel and Matilda Bickley-Turner's daughter Nancy in mid 1841 as recorded in Clay Co. Illinois. Samuel Jones and Sarah Smith's marriage 2-18-1817 recorded in Henry Co. Ky gives her father's name as Robert Smith. The Smith's, Jones's and Turner's lived within 5 or 6 homes from each other in Henry Co. Ky.

		<p>It is unknown when Robert and Elizabeth Neville-Smith died between 1840 and 1850 in Clay Co. No will or probate found.</p> <p>When Joseph Turner died on January 8, 1863 and Sarah Jones died in February 14, 1863, Catharine Turner married Samuel Jones on June 25, 1863 and he died in July 28, 1863. I believed he married his sister in law.</p> <p>Catharine Jones then married 2-21-1864 Dr. William Carpenter in Clay Co. Illinois. He died by 7-1-1865.</p> <p>She then married 11-14-1867 Henry H. Pyles in Clay Co. Illinois. They moved to Omega, Marion Co. Illinois. After her death in 1872, Henry married their next door neighbor Mrs. Amanda (nee Waugh) Hawkins. Henry died sometime in 1877 and Amanda moved to Kansas.</p> <p>Catharine and Joseph's son Samuel Joshua Turner married his second wife Malisa Waugh the daughter of Brice Waugh. Amanda (Waugh) Hawkins was related to Brice and his cousin Roderick Waugh (his sister). <i>(All records researched and furnished by Eva Myrick and included on this findagrave memorial.
