Cemetery is located in the southwest corner of the S.E. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 16 Town 4 North, Range 3 East of the Third P.M. Marion County, Illinois. It is situated at the edge of a high cliff and is now grown up in timber, being located on what is known as the Robnett timber. There is no road that leads to the cemetery ^{any more} and one can reach it only by walking there or if fields are dry and crops harvested it is possible to reach it by automobile thru the Russell Williams farm.

	<p>ROBB, Eli Died: July 2, 1854 (or July 7, 1854) Aged 46 yr 7 mn 16 da</p>	<p>Eli ROBB; Eli Robb, a native of Tennessee, who came to Marion county, Illinois, in 1820 and settled where Kinmundy now stands. He secured land which he converted into a valuable farm and made a comfortable home here, where he died in 1854 of cholera. He was one of the pioneers of this county. 	<i>(unable to read)</i>	<p>William Swift is listed in the 1850 and 1860 Marion County, IL census with his wife, Jane.</p> <p>According to census records William would have been born circa 1783/4 and Jane would have been born 1800. Both born in Va.</p> <p>They had a son, James M. Swift who was married at least 3 times. James married (1) 5 Dec 1846 (Marion County, IL, Bk A, page 25) to Mary Conant (see Shanghai Cemetery burial). James married (2) Elizabeth Garrett, 6 Nov 1856 (Marion County, IL, bk C, page 126). James married (3) to Mary Jennings Green, 15 May 1883 (Marion County, IL, bk D, page 162. It lists James M. Swift as being born in White County, TN and that his mothers maiden name was Jane Watson. Also states Mary Jennings Green is the daughter of Israel Jennings and Ann McClure; this being her 2nd marriage. Mary is also listed as having been born in Marion County.</p> <p>(Info. contributed by Lee Jones)</p>
