Of this marriage, he is survived by 5 children – William H., Thomas A., James F. and George A. SHAFFER, and Mrs. Sarah CHARLTON <i>(Newspaper obituary on page 139 in "Purcell Scrapbook #1)</i> He leaves to mourn his departure a brother in Kansas and 4 sons, 1 daughter - George SHAFFER returned to his home in Winchester, Ind., Monday after attending the funeral of his brother, W.H. SHAFFER, and visiting his brothers a few days.
